

What are Loose Parts?

Loose parts are any collection of natural or manmade objects that can be used to extend and further ideas in children's play. They are opened ended materials that can be moved, combined, taken apart, recreated, and lined up, and more. Loose parts are a way for children to interpret and use creative thinking on their own or with others; to build, deconstruct, persist, and create. It is a way for children to do the thinking of what they want something to become.

At SMS-SAP we would like to try Loose Parts and see what our brains can come up with, we are asking that each family brings in loose parts to make our dream come true. Ideas of parts that you could bring in are:

- sticks -clothes pins -straws -magnets -sea glass -paper rolls
- rocks -candle sticks -cups -spoons -ribbon -painters tape
- leaves -wood scraps -buttons -cans -rubber bands
- feathers -dried fruit -golf balls -bottle tabs -yarn
- shells -bottle caps -nuts and bolts -marbles -felt
- corks -bubble wrap -keys -gems -boxes
