**FORT FRANCES POLICE SERVICES BOARD SEEKS INDIVIDUALS
INTERESTED IN PROVINCIAL APPOINTMENT**

The Fort Frances Police Services Board (PSB) is seeking motivated, community minded individuals to apply for two provincially appointed positions on the board. Two current board members have been elected to council in the Town of Fort Frances, and have to vacate their positions on the Police Services Board.

The Fort Frances board is a five person board consisting of the following:

- 1) Two members are Town of Fort Frances council members,
- 2) One member is a citizen appointed by council,
- 3) Two members are citizens appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

This board governs the Ontario Provincial Police (O.P.P.) in the Town of Fort Frances, and serves as an advisory body. It meets on a monthly basis.

The primary function of this independent board is to liaise with the Detachment Commander of the Fort Frances OPP. They further provide oversight into policing duties in the Town of Fort Frances. The board is governed by the Police Services Act of Ontario.
