

The Town of Fort Frances is very thankful for the Ontario government providing the following three community infrastructure grants through the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation:

- \$366,375 to renovate the firehall making it more efficient and safer for emergency responders.
- \$187,500 to install a back-up power system at the municipal airport.
- \$30,000 to replace the roofing at the Senior Centre workshop, the mortuary, and the Point Park office.


Your contributions have been invaluable. Without your hard work and commitment, we wouldn't have been able to begun to have managed the demands that arise during the busy summer months.
