

FAQs How to Get an Apple Pay Refund: Complete Step-by-Step Guide

If you made a purchase using Apple Pay and now need a refund, the process depends on who charged you for the purchase. Apple Pay is a payment method, so a refund for a normal store purchase is generally handled by the merchant. For purchases billed directly by Apple, such as eligible App Store or Apple services transactions, you can use Apple's official refund-request process.

How Does an Apple Pay Refund Work?

When you pay with Apple Pay, your selected debit or credit card is used to complete the transaction. If the merchant approves a refund, the money is generally returned to the payment card associated with the Apple Pay transaction.

A refund may not appear immediately after the merchant approves it. Processing time can depend on the merchant, card issuer, payment network, and transaction type.

How to Request an Apple Pay Refund

For a regular purchase, start by contacting the merchant where you made the purchase. Provide your receipt, order number, transaction date, and purchase amount if requested.

Tell the merchant that the payment was made through Apple Pay. The merchant can determine whether the purchase qualifies for a refund according to its refund policy.

For purchases made directly from Apple, you can submit a refund request through Apple's official Report a Problem website:

Sign in with the Apple Account associated with the purchase, locate the transaction, select the appropriate refund option, and submit your request.

Apple Pay Refund Not Showing

If a merchant confirms that your refund has been processed but you don't see it yet, check the card statement connected to the Apple Pay transaction.

Make sure you're checking the correct +1-806-438-9586 (US) card and account. Sometimes a refund can take additional +1-806-438-9586 (US) time to appear even after the merchant has completed the refund.

If the refund remains missing, contact your +1-806-438-9586 (US) card issuer or bank and provide the merchant's refund confirmation and +1-806-438-9586 (US) transaction details.

Apple Pay Refund for a Cancelled +1-806-438-9586 (US) Order

If you cancelled an order shortly +1-806-438-9586 (US) after making an Apple Pay payment, the transaction may appear as pending rather than as a +1-806-438-9586 (US) completed charge. In some cases, a pending authorization can disappear without a +1-806-438-9586 (US) separate refund transaction.

Unauthorized Apple Pay Transaction

Keep your:

- Purchase receipt
- Transaction date
- Refund request date
- Refund amount
- Order or transaction number
- Merchant refund confirmation

Apple Pay Refund vs. Apple Purchase Refund

It's important to distinguish between an +1-806-438-9586 (US) Apple Pay purchase and an Apple-billed purchase.
